D i v i n e I n t e r v e n t i o n

Last Thursday we had guest speaker, Pastor Ian Hendricks give us a wonderful word on enjoying God's promise of favor. It is of great importance to reposition ourselves in the spirit in order to always hear from God. During this year, when God has promised favor, we need to make sure that we do not tolerate substandard spiritual life. We need to have a lifestyle trusting God and utterly depending on Him. Trust goes beyond faith! When we respond correctly and hold on to what God has promised, we can expect divine intervention in all aspects of our life.

Divine Favor, Pastor Ian explained, doesn't come because we are nice; it is a **divine intervention which comes because of God's covenant with us**. A covenant is a solemn binding agreement of all the parties involved, and is sealed by a vow and shedding of blood. It is a binding forever and involves commitment. Taking the example of Abraham, he explained how God had to reposition Abraham and change his expectations before He made a covenant. And even as Abraham was faithful, he received divine favor which changed his life forever. We can see this favor in the life of many in the Bible like Noah, Joseph etc . The same is applicable to each one of us who believe. We are all in covenant with God, a covenant that is sealed with the blood of Jesus. We are partakers of everything that Jesus has for us and when we walk in obedience to God's Word, we can expect God's favor. **When we obtain God's divine favor we can also enjoy His divine abundance, presence, companionship and authority to fulfill His divine purpose**. Remember, fulfillment of God's covenant in our lives requires our commitment to a life without compromise.

A b r a h a m ' s n e w i d e n t i t y

Last Friday, Pastor Ian explained that our spiritual life is a journey - a process. He portrayed how Abram after he heard and received the promise of God, journeyed ahead by obeying instructions from God and rearranging his life. God had to change Abram's thoughts, expectations and identity before He made a covenant with him. Abram had to stop journeying in his own strength and completely depend on God and be blameless. Abram had to separate himself from all wrong associations and every compromising life style that hindered the fulfillment of God's covenant. In the process God changed Abram to Abraham and his wife Sarai to Sarah. A new identity was given. And Abraham goes on to become the 'father of many nations' just the way God had promised. **Similarly each of us today need to be ready to take on the identity God gives us and leave behind how the world has labeled us so that we can enjoy God's promises in our lives.**

There are times, when we hear God and believe Him, but are unable to rightly see how God intends us to see. Seeing right in the spirit is very important. The moment we start seeing right in the spirit and connect with it, we can move into the next level of making a covenant and partake of it. When God makes a covenant, we should be alert not to allow anything to snatch it away from us. We need to take the Word of God and fight.

It is also very important to be in total agreement with those who are with you, specially the family, in order to see the fulfillment of the promise. It is when Abraham and his wife (who also gets a new identity) were in total agreement that their breakthrough came. Another valuable point to be noted is that fulfillment of the covenant comes with the visitation from the Lord. It is only then we can enjoy God's promises in it's fullness.
