The Laws of Life (Part 1 & 2)

On Thursday, Pastor Ashish spoke on how we can enter into eternal life.

We saw that accepting Jesus is the first step but, that alone will not do – but it is required for us to keep the commandments in order to attain eternal life. We see this in (Mt 19. 16 -19), where Jesus tells the man who was seeking eternal life to keep the commandments. In another incident, we see in (Lk 10: 25 – 37), where Jesus speaking to a lawyer says that in order to attain eternal life - it was important to not only love God but also to love our neighbours as ourselves. Through the parable we were able to identify that our neighbour is one who helps us, takes care of us and prays for us through our difficult times.

On Friday, Pastor Ashish continued with Thursday's message by going on to say that not only does the Word tell us to love our neighbours, and it also warns us in (Exo 20. 16, 17) not to covet anything that belongs to our neighbour!

We also saw in (Lk 19.40 – 41), that Jesus cried over the City of Jerusalem because it did not know the time of its visitation. The enemy tries to keep people in captivity so that they will not be able to praise God and hence will be able to come against them. But, if we can praise God in the midst of our troubles just as we read in (Acts 16. 25, 26) then we will be able to discern the time of our visitation and will enjoy our breakthrough!
