L a w s o f L i f e - 9

Last Thursday Pastor Ashish continued teaching us on the principles of Life. Stating the importance of living by the Word of God, he explained how one can partake of eternal life, in other terms, to once again eat of the Tree of Life which was blocked because of the sin of man. The answer lies in Jesus. We can have eternal life when we eat of Life, which is the person of Jesus Himself. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. Jesus said, "Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him". Many didn't understand that Jesus is the Word that was made flesh and dwelt among men. He is the bread of life. **It is all about eating the Word that is manifested.**

Pastor also explained that there is a process involved in seeing the Word of God being manifested in our lives. God released His Word and sent it through His messenger, Gabriel, who spoke it on the earth. Pastor illustrated how Mary believed that Word, received that Word, nurtured and held on to the Word and finally had the Word manifested. It is the same process in every believer's life. Many of us get the Word, but miss out the process in which the Word is nurtured and brought forth in its fullness. It is similar to how the baby grows in the mother's womb. The Word that God gives us has to go through a process of nurturing, till it is matured and manifested. There is a process of time and effort! **It has to be received, believed, nurtured till it's fullness, and brought forth in due time.**

Another important thing in order to receive the Word, is that we need to hunger for it. The lack of hunger shows sickness in the spirit. We need to be expectant and eager. Similar to the process of eating and digesting our food daily, always remember that when we receive the Word, there is a process of swallowing and digesting it in order to take in the nutrients. The Word would need to go inside us where all the nutrients are absorbed to its full extent. Another fact is that each kind of food has a different intensity. The time required to get all the goodness out of it depends on how strong the food is. Some receive milk, which is easier to digest, but some receive meat which requires more time and effort. How much we benefit depends on the effort we are willing to put in.

How much effort do we take to digest the Word that we are receiving week after week? It is our choice. And the choice we make will surely manifest! If we hold on to the Word, it will surely manifest in our lives.

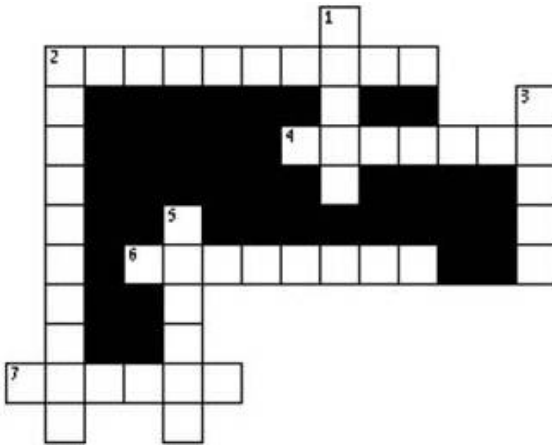
