RECEIVING THROUGH WORSHIP

Last Thursday, Pastor Ashish taught us on how to receive through worship. It is important to understand the supernatural realm in order to be able to receive the natural things from the invisible realm of God. Understanding this realm will help us encounter God in a different level. If we do, then there will be no limits caused by our ignorance. We were taught to always live by sight which resulted in our inability to comprehend the things which are unseen. But the scripture speaks about a sight which can perceive the unseen. It is our spiritual sight. Just as in the natural realm we can understand the creator from his creation, the invisible God can be understood and seen through the things He created, Romans 1:20.

An other important way to understand God intimately is through worship. Worship is not just singing songs or an external act. There is an intimate realm created as we truly worship God. And as we get into this place of worship, supernatural things can happen. Pastor, using the instance of the leper who came in reverence and worships Jesus and receives his miracle (Math 8), revealed our opportunity to receive the supernatural. It is at the time of worship that the leper gets the deep revelation of Jesus' ability to make him clean, and he breaks the silence and makes his request to Jesus. And we see that the leper receives his miracle. Another thing to note is that a request is not made during worship. While we truly worship, there is no selfish motive. The aim of worship is meant to bring us into this place where we can get a revelation of God, His attributes, His nature, His power and ability to touch the deepest and smallest part of His creation.

Though in recent times reverential worship is not easily understood, it is important to those in the Kingdom of God, to have a culture of honor and reverence to God, the King of Kings. The new testament worship is similar to a dog licking it's master. By doing so, it shows its affection, gratitude and faithfulness with no other motive. In worship we enter into a similar place where every part of our being comes in reverence to our Master and Creator, the King of kings. This is our secret place—involving just God and you. And it is at these moments of intimate worship we have a revelation - on the awesomeness of God. And here we are positioned to receive the supernatural! Let us not take worship lightly. Let us enjoy every moment of worship, wanting to know and understand our awesome God.

The Invisible Realm of God

On Friday, Pastor Ashish continued to share the Word on how to draw from 'The invisible realm of God'. We need to train ourselves to experience from the realm that seems to be invisible but is true, and not just be led by our natural senses.

Looking into the life of Moses, we see he was brought up in the palace of the Pharaoh, but his heart desired to pursue God, Hebrews 11:25-27. He left all the earthly position and pleasures in order to draw close to the invisible God. Similarly we also need to be ready to leave anything that hinders us from our walk with God. There may be times of lonely wandering like in the life of Moses but we can see that God meets us when we are serious about our walk with Him! During our spiritual journey God will teach us how to overcome all our challenges. But there has to be a clear transition and separation from the worldly things, in order to receive the spiritual. Sin may be pleasurable, but it develops a nature of our body which pulls us more towards the natural and physical realm and we will end up being blind to the invisible. But if we draw ourselves fully away from worldly influences, our intimacy with God will increase and we will be able to perceive the unseen. We will be able to enjoy the invisible and supernatural realm as we walk with God.
