THE INVISIBLE REALM OF GOD - 4

Last Thursday, Pastor Ashish taught us about the importance of endurance in order to see the invisible realm of God manifest in our lives. Endurance is the ability to withstand pressure for a long time. It shows character. Moses endured to see the invisible. We are blessed when we endure trials and temptations. Character and trust is built during periods of trial when we stand our ground and trust the Word of God. We also need to realize that 'correction is for sons' (Hebrews 12:7). God corrects us when we are wrong because He loves us so much and we being His children, need to be open to His correction. And even as we endure the chastening of the Lord, we will be partakers of every heavenly blessing which is ours in Christ Jesus.

In Genesis we see how Adam was able to see and enjoy the invisible realm before the fall. Later they disobeyed the invisible instruction and gave into the temptation of eating of the Tree of the knowledge of good and evil because the woman thought what she saw was good. They saw in the natural and thus fell to the natural visible realm. It requires strong character to stick to the invisible instruction. God does not look at the outward appearance but looks inside. We need to make ourselves good in the inside. God wants to develop character and right attitudes in each of us through obedience. We need to allow Him to mould us as we endure hardships. Let us not be stubborn but yield to Him completely so that we can be refined and perfected. Another important instruction was to purposefully **dig the ground**. Similar to the ground that Adam was asked to dig, is our Memory, Experience and Nurturing (MEN). These three things effect our lives to a great extent to either make us or break us. We need to learn to dig these three areas and find out the natures that are wrong in us and deal with it and correct it with God's Word. Then we will be totally free to see right and have abundant life.

THE INVISIBLE REALM OF GOD - 5

Last Friday, Pastor Ashish continued to teach us on how to rightly see the invisible. After the fall, man had lost the focus of the invisible. But even as the truth starts to become strong in us, our focus will be right on God and we shall indeed be restored to the level of the supernatural. As we develop our focus and make sure there is no greed or guile in us, we will be able to see the impossible take place.

By constantly hearing the Word of God; doubt is removed; faith is developed and character is built. Most of the time God trains us first in obedience. And it is of great importance to train ourselves in obedience even to the finest details. Saul's lack of obedience to the details of the instruction was the reason for his loss. The invisible stopped moving on his behalf! We can learn a lot from this.

Taking the incident of a man born lame but healed by Peter and John at the temple gate (Acts 3), Pastor taught us the importance of focus while we receive. We also need to understand that God always wants to give us all that is good. But we need to learn to expect and receive it from Him. We should never get into the place of disappointment when we do not get things we asked for. The beggar would have been disappointed when Peter said they did not have silver or gold. But he received something more significant - He could walk! Likewise we can trust God to give us the very best! **But first we**



need to learn to expect- respect- look up- and not be disappointed in order to receive from the person who has the capacity to give us what we need. We need to understand authority which is invisible, and that there is great power in obeying authority and receiving from those placed in authority. And also REMEMBER-What keeps us going is invisible!
