THE INVISIBLE REALM OF GOD - 6

Last Thursday, we received an awesome Word from our Senior Pastor Rekha Thomas, as she brought forth fresh revelation and awareness of God's supernatural and invisible realm! The hunger and awareness of this realm will remove the limitations of our mind and will help us prepare for a totally new level in our walk with God.

Amazing revelation about faith and endurance from Hebrews 10, 11 & 12 was brought forth. As we read the scriptures, we see all the heroes of faith hold on to God's promises till they saw it manifest in their lives, and as a result received appreciation from God. Each of them persisted with an awareness of the invisible God and were able to see beyond the natural vision. Moses was drawn and open to the supernatural and invisible realm. He had trained himself in the invisible, and was ready to give attention to it, because of which he had amazing encounters with God. Similarly, if we are open to this supernatural realm, we too can enjoy close fellowship with God.

She also explained that understanding the invisible can help us endure. Moses even before he saw God face to face was aware of the invisible God, and endured many hardships and came out as a champion. The way we handle challenges will determine our future. Endurance is something each of us need to develop. God always complimented people who endured in faith and has no delight in those who give up easily (Hebrews 10:38). In Hebrews 11:1, Faith is explained as the confidence we have of things we hope for; things which are good and beneficial, and a hope that is totally on God. We may be going through challenges but we need to have confidence in God that He will change things for us. We need to endure till we see the promises of God come to pass in our lives. During this period it is important that we do not have memories of the past that would keep us from moving forward to the better things God has promised us. Taking the example of Abraham, Pastor explained how we can constantly go back to God to draw strength and continue to hold on to His Word. We are not alone in these battles, because we have the Holy Spirit with us to help us. We need to take His help and take a stand and endure, and when we do so, we will surely receive a great reward. Another fascinating revelation that can help us endure, is the awareness of the unseen realm witnessing our faith. The verse Hebrews 11:1, explains about an evidence of the unseen. Angels are witness to all that we do and stand for. Jesus reveals that it is not enough that we testify of ourselves. Even legally, a testimony is valid only when it is supported by two or more witnesses. So remember, it is neither the testimony we say about ourselves nor another man's testimony that is acceptable before God, but the testimony of the unseen realm that is going to be valid.

We need to understand that the unseen realm of God, which involves angels, is nothing to be afraid of. The angels are ministering spirits who are meant to help us. When we take a stand and hold on to the Word of God, the angels are our witness and evidence of our faith before the Father. And when the Father gets their witness about our faith, He will be pleased. The elders obtained a good testimony from them about their endurance and persistence. Sometimes we may be alone when we face challenges, but we need to remember and be encouraged with the fact that there is an unseen cloud of witnesses that will testify of our faith. Our prayers ascends up before God out of the angel's hand (Rev 8:4). Angels watch us to see how we endure trials and temptation, and when we endure, they move to minister to us. Their testimony before the Father about the stand we take, will surely bring recompense that we cannot imagine. There are so many powerful revelations that Pastor Rekha brought forth about how involved and dependent we are on the unseen realm. It is important that we are aware of it. Please do not miss this teaching that we need to hear and take hold of.
