AMAZING WEEK WITH REV. REINHARD BONNKE

Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke who has touched millions through his powerful ministry, preached the Word in The Dubai City Church on Thursday and Friday the 20th & 21st May, 2010. People were immensely touched by the Word and many were healed of their infirmities during the powerful services. Above all, every person who came to the services went back touched and transformed with a passion to reach out to the world with the power of the Gospel.

Reverend Bonnke was a true inspiration to us! He believed that every Christian has to be passionate about winning souls and be empowered by the Holy Spirit to do so. He shared with us his burning passion for the Gospel, a vision for Africa and a message for the world. His motto is to plunder hell and populate heaven. He also shared his amazing personal testimony about how he gave his life to the Lord at the age of nine, and heard the call to the African mission field before he was even a teenager. God placed upon his heart the vision of 'the continent of Africa, washed in the precious Blood of Jesus'. When he had started his mission in Africa he preached to just as few as five, but trusting God's plan he held on, and now he preaches to as many as 1,600,000 people in a single gathering. He was a wonderful example of how God could move through a completely yielded life.

He shared many nuggets of truth which blessed us in a very special way. Speaking on the importance of preaching the Gospel he said, -'The Gospel of Christ is the "power of God" when preached (Rom 1:16)'. Preaching Christ, releases the power of God. He said that 'The Good News' - only becomes news when one shares it and someone else hears it. 'Preach Christ and the Holy Spirit at once joins in' he reiterated. Even from the beginning, there is a working relationship between the Word of God and the Spirit of God. The work of the Holy Spirit is specifically to confirm the things of Christ.

Rev. Bonnke brought forth the wonderful revelation from the verse '...For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it' Mathew 7:12-14, Rev. Bonnke said - now that the Cross of Calvary is become the greatest road block of all times, many can be saved from the road to destruction and be redirected to the road to life!

He expounded about the promise of God's faithfulness in the biggest and smallest situations in our lives and compared it to the marriage vows one takes for better and for worse. He also explained the baptism of fire, and how Jesus would completely immerse every bit of us in the river of liquid fire and we could totally be on fire for God. It was also amazing to hear about the unique flame of fire (i.e. anointing) given to each individual, just like finger prints. None of them are the same; Each one is different and an original and all our differences reflect Him. He also compared the Holy Spirit to a pacemaker, who brings us in pace with the heart of God, to the rhythm of His heart.

Another important counsel he gave us was never to envy and fight over someone else's anointing and power. If we desire to have an anointing, we need to turn to God who is the source of the anointing; for God is more than willing to impart that which is ours if we yield completely to Him.

We are so privileged to partake of this impartation from Rev. Reinhard Bonnke. We thank our pastors, Pastor Ashish and Pastor Rekha for sharing this great blessing with us.
