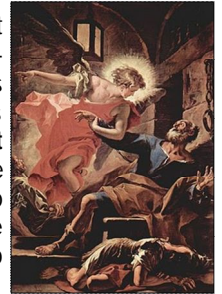

THE INVISIBLE REALM OF GOD – 7 & 8

The word we are receiving in this season about the invisible realm of God is sure to change our destiny and lead us into an amazing walk with God. Last week, Pastor Rekha explained how the angels are so involved with our day to day lives. They are not just there to bring messages from God to us, she clarified, which is how our limited understanding is framed. They are involved intimately in watching our lives, ministering to us, carrying prayers and testimonies of our endurance to God, etc. And their ministry will continue even till end times when they will separate the righteous from the wicked because they have been witness to all that happens.

The Bible is filled with amazing stories of supernatural involvement and deliverances in the lives of heroes of faith. Moses' amazing encounters, Joshua's encounter with the Captain of Hosts, Peter's amazing escape from the extensively guarded prison etc. **Angels moved to help those whose trust and faith was on God, in the most astounding manner!** It is not to be taken lightly. We all desire to have such an encounter with the invisible, but for this we need to develop an awareness of the invisible realm. Having an awareness about the invisible will help us hold on in faith till we overcome. We need to understand that even as we hold in faith, the unseen testifies of it to God, and will move on our behalf. So let us be encouraged in this, and rise up to believe in God's promises no matter what the hindrances may be or how impossible it may seem to be. Also remember, it is in this process that we are shaped and perfected and we mature as sons of God.



Pastor Rekha also helped us realize that though we may know the scripture that says 'the angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear God', how far is our understanding and recognition about the same? There was a time, when Lot recognized angels when they appeared as men. How? Because he was aware of this realm through Abraham. Likewise, we need to be aware of this realm. We need to understand that angels are always on God's side and those who walk in obedience to the Word of God will also be able to be ministered by them. But if anyone walks in rebellion to God's Word, they may face opposition from this very supernatural beings. This is not something to be afraid of but used as caution in examining our responses to the various issues and standards in our lives. In the Garden of Eden we can see how the angel blocked the way to the Tree of Life after the fall of man, or see in the life of Balaam an incident when the angel blocked his path, of which he was not even aware until after his donkey spoke like a human! Let stubbornness never blind us like it did to Balaam.

It is also important to understand that God expects each of us to abide by the Kingdom principles. We need to be very careful to respect authority. This is one of the important principles in the Kingdom of God. God does not appreciate anyone jumping ranks, whether it be in the smallest unit of family, i.e., wife over her husband or to the bigger units of authority such as people living in rebellion against authorities. The angels watch over this, as they know this was the very reason for the fall of Lucifer along with the angels who were in rebellion. The angels of the Lord do not partake in rebellion nor move for their sakes when people walk in rebellion.

'**God requires truth in the inward parts**' (Ps 51:6) was another simple truth which Pastor Rekha kept bringing to our attention. It was simple yet so profound. Our focus has to be on pleasing God, our Father, and the supernatural will naturally move for us. May our understanding of the invisible realm not be limited to our natural sight but be ready to be transformed by the renewing of our mind by truth and revelation from the Word of God. *Let us not be like those of the world who have lost their capacity to endure, but be among those who endure and come out perfected and victorious.*
