THE INVISIBLE REALM OF GOD - 9 & 10

What an awesome God we serve and what an amazing experience of dwelling in His presence and being set free by the power of His Word!

Last Thursday Pastor Ashish continued to teach us on understanding the invisible realm of God. He encouraged each of us to dwell in the truth of this realm and make it a part of our lives. It was amazing to see Jesus' ability to see through the hearts of people. Pastor explained how this was possible by each of us too! He gave us the secrets on how we could tap into this realm of revelation.

Nathaniel had this kind of insight. He understood that Jesus was the 'Son of God and King of Israel' even before anyone told him. How? It was because he was a person without guile. He had clear vision as a result of a lifestyle which had no deceit, trickery or pretense. Nathaniel clearly understood Jeremiah 1:4-7, that said, God chose him before he was born. He clearly understood the scriptures. Nathaniel and his friends dwelt so much in the scriptures and desired to know more. That is the secret of being open to the incorruptible invisible realm. We should be people who will deeply desire the things of God. And instead of living a lifestyle of pretense, we need to be open before God and be willing change. When there is a genuine desire of the things of God, truly God will cause our eyes to open to great things in His invisible realm.

On Friday Pastor Ashish explained about captivity and how to come out of it. Bruises are the first level in the enemy's attack to take our lives captive, he explained. The enemy inflicts bruises on our life in order to cause us to focus on ourselves and our pain. It is the level in which the enemy tries to get beyond our protection level. Bruises though superficial, are painful. It leads to blindness and finally takes one into captivity and bondage. It is progressive in nature, if it is not dealt with.

Captivity means to be taken and kept against our will. The enemy likes to take our minds, will, emotions, time, resources, energy etc., captive. We are not to allow ourselves remain in captivity. The Lord has paid the price and there is no reason why we should be in bondage! We can see how to free ourselves from being held captive through the life of Jesus. Jesus was bruised (Math 26:38), but He overcame the bruise even as He asked the Father to save! He then rises up in strength and did not allow Himself to be blind. His vision was clear. He could see clearly that in three days He would rise again!

The first thing we need to understand is that – God has seen us and has a plan for us even from the beginning. Even before man made the mistake in the Garden of Eden, God had planned what to do and declared what He was going to do (Genesis 3:15). So - Captive, blind, or bruised, there is hope for full restoration! Jesus came to heal every bruise, open every blind eye and set captives free.

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

From Psalms 126, we can see how to get out of captivity

- Remember the great things that God has done for us in the past
- Be glad and declare what He has done
- Ask God to turn our activity to cause the rivers to flow one more time

And even as we are open before God in all sincerity and truth and ask Him to turn our captivity, the truth of Isaiah 61 shall come alive. The Spirit of the Lord shall touch us and cause the river of life to overflow and fill our soul and make the deserts to bloom. Then indeed the heathen shall see our lives and declare that the Lord has done great things for us!
