Last Thursday Pastor Ashish gave us the Word which encouraged each one of us to hold on in faith and never give up. **God is a very present help in times of trouble.** We need to trust Him. The whole world seems to be going through trouble but we can be assured that God will keep us safe in the midst of it all. The children of God whose mind is stayed on God will see greater opportunities during this time. Natural disasters may take place but as the Psalmist says we need to be still and know that we have a great God who is our refuge and strength. Those of the world may be shaken, in darkness, and without hope but those who trust in the Lord will be made glad. Just like how God safely kept Noah and his family when the rest of the world was destroyed, Daniel when he was thrown into the lions den, and Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego when thrown into the fiery furnace, He promises to help us and keep us safe.

Pastor helped us understand the ways in which God moves. One is His Sovereign ways, and other is His special ways. His special ways result in mighty acts on behalf of those who have a right standing with Him. God made His ways known to Moses and His acts unto the children of Israel. God wants each of us to know His ways of righteousness and truth and walk in it. When we do so, it will bring the mighty acts of God.

The most important advice during tough times is - not to fear. If we allow the spirit of fear to have any place in our lives, it will start to dominate us. It will influence our thinking and actions. It will prevent us from thinking right. Instead of allowing fear to control our minds, we need to constantly remind ourselves of the various times God has delivered His people from trouble. Using the amazing story of how Moses' mother rescued Moses from Pharaoh, Pastor explained how **important it is to reflect on God's mighty acts, and have a point of reference in order to battle our challenges and receive our breakthroughs.** Moses' mother could have just accepted the fact that she had to give up her baby like how the other women did. But she choose to accomplish the impossible, and made strategies as she reminded herself how God kept Noah safe during the flood inside the ark. Her confidence was on God's promise of deliverance and indeed she saw the deliverance !

We need to encourage ourselves by referring to the "great works of God", no matter how great the challenge may seem to be, knowing that "God is able". We need to cover ourselves with the promises of God and stand on it till we see it being fulfilled in our lives. God will enable us to overcome any situation when we trust in Him and hold on. When we calm ourselves in God, He will give us wisdom to handle any situation. But it all depends on whether we are ready to think differently and rise up in our thinking. Each of us have two choices. One choice is to think like the world thinks and 'flow down with it' or the other choice is to rise up and line our thinking to the Word of God which is the truth that brings freedom! Let us not give into the lower levels of thinking but agree to the fact that God's thoughts and ways are much higher than man's. God is Faithful. Remember -God is the same - Yesterday, Today and for Forever.

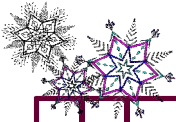
